

From MAEO: Rolando and Yessenia Mejia, our missionaries in Nicaragua, have had two significant financial burdens come into their lives in the past 4 months. After saving for several years, Rolando bought a car to help transport his church members working in the women's prison ministry. He was involved in an accident and the car was totaled. Because he does not have insurance, he estimates a cost of \$4000 to replace the car. Then with Hurricane Eta, 25 inches of rain fell in a short amount of time and the beams of his house roof sagged and water poured into his house. The cost to repair the roof is \$8000. A short video showing the roof condition is showing on the screens in back of church. With the loan interest rate at 18% and Rolando and Yessenia already surviving on a meager income, the Evangelism Committee is inviting the congregation to provide additional funds beyond our regular support to help him with these financial burdens. A box has been

placed near the Welcome Center where gifts can be placed or given to a deacon. The goal is to raise \$12,000 with \$3000 already contributed. Questions can be directed to Stan Wynia or Ted Altena.

**Talking Bibles project**. Our congregation will again participate in the "Talking Bibles" Christmas tree project. Many people are either unable to read or have no access to a printed Bible. The solar-powered Talking Bible is available in many different languages enabling individuals or groups to hear the Bible in their own language. Each year the Talking Bible organization focuses on one country. This year it is Africa. The cost of one Bible is \$50. A matching gift of 4 more Bibles will be added for every Bible our congregation donates. Donations can be brought to the office, placed in the offering bucket or placed in the mailbox. Each week ornaments will be placed on the tree in the back of church representing the number of Talking Bibles donated. Watch for the progress each week.
